

## *Descendants of James McClenny*

### *Generation No. 1*

1. JAMES<sup>1</sup> MCCLENNY was born August 22, 1797 in South Carolina, and died November 03, 1843 in Illinois. He married ESTHER MCRACHIN November 05, 1822 in North Carolina. She was born December 28, 1799 in Charlotte, North Carolina, and died November 05, 1877 in Valley Falls, Jefferson County, Kansas.

Notes for JAMES MCCLENNY:

Family records from Mrs. Fred Coulson indicates James was of Irish descent. A newspaper article published in Kansas about the McClenny family reunion mentioned, "A message was read from Noel Dorr, first secretary of the Embassy of Ireland, Washington, indicating the origins of the McClenny family in Ireland. The main sect of the family originated in the western counties from the Westmeath-Roscommon area, whence they spread west of the Shannon and even as far north as Donegal."

We conclude that James was born in South Carolina based on his son, John Hamilton McClenny's, 1880 United States Census information, which stated his father was born in South Carolina.

James and Esther obtained a marriage license in Mecklenberg County, North Carolina on November 5, 1822. His name on the license was listed as James Cleny.

The publication "North and South Carolina Marriage Records From the Earliest Colonial Days to the Civil War" compiled and edited by William Montgomery Clemens, Editor of Genealogy Magazine, published by Genealogical Publishing Company of Baltimore, Maryland, page 60 lists a marriage between Esther McRachin and John Clancy, 5 November 1822, Mecklenburg County, North Carolina.

James must have lived in Tennessee at some point in time as his son, John Hamilton McClenny, reported that was the state in which he was born.

A family member commented that it was said James was a blacksmith in Illinois.

The 1830 US Census, page 243, line 09, record 289 lists a James McClenny.

Notes for ESTHER MCRACHIN:

Her maiden name has also been questioned to be McCreaken.

The publication "North and South Carolina Marriage Records From the Earliest Colonial Days to the Civil War" compiled and edited by William Montgomery Clemens, Editor of Genealogy Magazine, published by Genealogical Publishing Company of Baltimore, Maryland, page 179 lists a marriage between Esther McRachin and John Clancy, 5 November 1822, Mecklenburg County, North Carolina.

Her obituary was published in "The Kansas New Era" Valley Falls, Jefferson County, Kansas on Saturday November 17, 1877. "Died - November 5, 1877 after long continued feebleness, Mrs. Esther McClenny, well known among the older residents of Jefferson County. Mrs. McClenny was born in Charlotte, North Carolina 12-28-1799. She settled in Illinois in 1830 and after the death of her husband, some 25 years ago, she moved in 1857 to Jefferson County, Kansas. The tolls and trials of a new country, she bore with cheerfulness. At age 14 years, she united with the Presbyterian Church, and her life evinced the genuineness of her Christian profession. Coming to Kansas she joined Congregational Church, Valley Falls and lived and died in the faith. The kindly remembrance of her cheerful and consistant christian life is a continued feast of comfort to the hearts of the many friends and relatives that survive her. The memory of the righteous is blessed."

John was the treasurer of the Brush Creek (Pacific) School from 1869 until 1883.

The "Valley Falls Historical Society Newsletter" dated February 25, 1975 has the following entry: "The other item brought by Alex was a piece of Kansas Military script issued during the Indian troubles in western Kansas during the 1870's. This piece was assigned to Mr. John McClenny."

The "Kansas Historical Quarterly" page 468 has the following entry under Marriage Notices from Kansas Territorial Newspapers 1854-1861. "McClenny, John N. and Ellen Gettis, mar. Jan 1, 1856, at house of John Adkinson, by the Rev. John Evans. (Atchison, Squatter Sovereign, Jan. 22).

The "Valley Falls" newspaper published John Hamilton McClenny's obituary on April 2, 1885. "John McClenny born in the state of Tennessee, October 13, 1825, when quite young, removed with his parents to Bond County, Illinois where he resided until the spring of 1855, at which time he moved to Kansas, and located on the same place until his death, March 28th 1885. Thus we are called upon to chronicle the death of another highly esteemed friend and citizen, a dear husband and affectionate father, leaving an aching void that no earthly tie can kill. But what is our loss, is his eternal gain. That in his life there were imperfections, we know he would have us record. Who can say I never have sinned? Not one. But that he had a good hope in the Saviour, we rejoice he has left us evidence and in his last moments could shout - even, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me: thy rod and thy staff they comfort me.' He knew that his time was at hand, and was conscious till the last moment. Kissing his wife and children and giving them words of counsel he quietly folded his hands, and took his departure into the land of eternal bliss, where they swell the anthems of the redeemed with none so sweet as that in which he joins - the song of Moses and the Lamb. Let his life be the eulogy our lips would pronounce. Well known for many years in this community, he has a host of friends who lament his death and unite in extending sympathy to the bereaved, as was witnessed by the great concourse which gathered at the residence. A husband kind and true. A father who was always affable, loving and indulgent to his children. A faith triumphant in Christ. The writer preached a discourse at the house Sunday, March 29th 1885 from Phil 1:21. Music was furnished by C.F. Bliss and wife, Frank Pancost, and Mrs. I. B. Schneffer, organist. By request of deceased the song was sung. - 'The morning flowers display their sweets, And gay their ..iken leaves unfold. As careless of the noontide heats; As fearless of the evening cold.' And then a well worn testament was used, which reminded one of the words of G. P. Morris. 'This book is all that's left me now, Tears will unbidden start. With faltering lips, and throbbing brow, I press it to my heart. The mines of earth no treasures give, that could this volume buy: In teaching me the way to live, It taught me how to die.' After the service a procession half a mile long proceeded to the church yard, when the last tribute of respect was paid the dead. The body rests till changed from the corruptible to the incorruptible. The grave has no sting to the christian, tis but a veil that separates between us and Him who is the Life, the Light, the Way, and through whom we have an abundant entrance into the greenwood of soul. May we all say with Paul - 'For to me to ...'

Notes for ELLEN GETTIS:

The "Okaloosa Independent" newspaper published the following obituary on February 18, 1871. "Died - Jan. 10th, 1871, Ellen, wife of John McClenny, at his residence near Grasshopper Falls, Kansas, aged 32 years. Sister McClenny was born in Huntingdon County, Indiana; moved to Kansas in 1855; was converted the first of January 1869, and joined the M.C. Church soon after. She lived in the full enjoyment of religion - was a good wife and kind mother. A few minutes before she died, she called her husband and five children to her bedside, and prayed with ... fervor for them; after she had ... them by name to the Grand Shepherd, she said, 'There, now you will be cared for.' She died in the full assurance of faith in Christ. J.A. Simpson, Pastor.

Mary's obituary was taken from the "Valley Falls Vindicator" dated January 20, 1928, page 1, column 4. Mrs. Mary H. Griffin, the daughter of Sylvanus and Sarah Carey was born near Bethlehem, Indiana on April 22nd

1847. In 1864 she moved with her parents to Springdale, Kansas where she resided with them until her marriage to John McClenny in 1872. To this union were born several children, some of whom died in infancy. But two of them survive, Mrs. Nellie Miller of Nortonville, Kansas and Mrs. Alice Foley of San Pedro, California. The latter daughter was unable to be here because of sickness. Mr. McClenny passed away March 15th 1885. In 1887 she was married to A. A. Griffin and to this union was born their son, Louis, who with his sister Nellie has taken such excellent care of the Mother all through her long illness. Mr. A. A. Griffin attained his heavenly reward April 12, 1921. Mrs. Griffin was a Birthwright member of the Friends or Quaker Church until September 4th 1898 when she and her daughter Nellie came into the Boyle M.E. Church which at that time was held in the Pacific school house. Our saintly friend peacefully departed this life early Wednesday morning January 11, 1928 at the age of eighty years, eight months and twenty days. There were surviving her brother Z. M. Carey of Lawrence, Kansas who though past eighty seven years of age is able to be with us today. Mr. Carey was in the Civil War at the time the family moved to Kansas. There are also living fifteen grandchildren and two great grandchildren. The funeral service for Mrs. Griffin was conducted at 2:30 p.m. Friday January 12th in the Boyle M.E. church by the pastor the Reverend James B. Wright and interment was made in the family lot in Spring Grove cemetery."

The "Oskaloosa Independent" newspaper had the following obituary on July 9, 1870:

"DIED - June 20th of Pneumonia and Whooping cough, near G.... Falls. Charles M, eldest son of John H. and Ellen McClenny. Age, 13 years, 7 months and 23 days. Charles was a good boy and only known to be loved. He was ....., obedient, and faithful to his parents, kind and obliging to all with whom he associated. He was a faithful attendant at Sabbath School, and early learned to love the Savior. He possessed a degree of ..... far beyond his years, ..... was borne with Christian courage and patience. He had a clear evidence of his acceptance with God. A few hours before his death he sang in a clear voice a part of one of the Sabbath School hymns he loved so well - 'Shall we sing in heaven forever!' He seemed to drink in the spirit of the song and rejoice that he was nearing that happy land. While it was evident the 'silver cord was giving way,' he exclaimed - 'Mother, do you see those beautiful, bright gardens up yonder? Oh! they are so beautiful!' A short while and Charles was taken to that 'house which has foundations, whose builder and maker is God.'" "Lo! each the child whose early feet The paths of peace have trod. Whose secret heart, with influence sweet, Is upward drawn to God."

Emerette was known as Retha. She was a school teacher at Half Mound # 46 in Kansas from 1878 through 1880.

Her obituary reads, "Miss Retba McClenny, aged twenty-nine years, daughter of the late John McClenny, died last Sunday evening at about 10 o'clock, at the residence of her sister, Mrs. George Bothwell, of this city, after a lingering illness of almost two years duration. She was a victim of consumption, but bore her suffering with commendable fortitude. The funeral took place Monday afternoon from the home of the deceased southeast of the city. Rev. E. F. Hill conducting ther services, and the remains were laid away in Spring Hill Cemetery. She was a good Christian girl, being a member of the Baptist church, exhibiting unusual interest in religious affairs up to the very hour of her death. She leaves behind hosts of friends to mourn her loss, and to them one and all, the New Era extends its heartfelt sympathy."

The "Valley Falls New Era" newspaper published her obituary on September 27, 1888.

"Miss Elizabeth McClenny was born in Bond County, Illinois in 1827. She professed religion and united with the church, when twelve years of age. Married to Joe T. Allen in 1852. Came to Kansas and settled near Valley Falls, Jefferson County in 1856, where she died August 12, 1888, age 61 years. She lived a consistent christian and died in the christian faith. The early itinerant minister of Kansas always found a welcome home at her house. 'A precious one from us has gone; A voice we loved is stilled. A place is vacant in our home, Which never can be filled. God in His wisdom has recalled, The boon His love had given. And though the body moulders here, The soul is safe in Heaven.'"

He may also have been known as Williamson Colwell McClenny. Some reports say he was born in Bloomington, Illinois. He left Galesburg, Illinois in 1854 and went to Kansas and homesteaded a farm near Valley Falls near Dunavant (Jefferson County), KS. The grant of the land was done through a treaty with the Delaware Indian Tribe. It is written on sheepskin and is signed by President Buchanan.

The following information comes from his obituary:

"He enjoyed a beautiful Christian experience, having united with the M.E. Church when 19 years of age. Thro' the last three weeks of his illness, he bore his intense suffering with patience and oft-times said he was ready to go should the Master call. The last day seemed to be his best. He was about the house and out of doors most of the day, even answered the telephone after 7 o'clock in the evening. About 11, p.m. he awoke and soon complained of his heart, and in five minutes he was gone with no one present but the faithful wife. The funeral was held at the

M.E. Church Friday afternoon, Rev. Cannon, his pastor, conducting the service."

William G. Cutler's "HISTORY OF THE STATE OF KANSAS, JEFFERSON COUNTY, PART 19" states, "W.C. McClenny, farmer, Section 2, P.O. Valley Falls, is a native of Illinois, and was born in Madison County, May 29, 1839, and was there educated and reared. In 1856, came to Kansas, locating a claim where he now resides; he was then a comparative youth. The border war was at that time at its zenith, and Mr. McClenny, being a strong Free-soiler, took an active part. In 1862, enlisted in Company I, Second Kansas Cavalry, being Sergeant of the company; participated at the battle of Pea Ridge and other engagements, serving until the close; was discharged July 4, 1865. After the war turned his attention to farming, which he has pursued the greater portion of the time. For three years, has been a guard at the Kansas State Penitentiary. He is a member of the I.O.O.F. Valley Falls Lodge, No. 86. He was married in September, 1866, to Miss Mary E. Byram. They have three children - John E., Elias and Charles W."

His first wife, Hester Ann Campbell died in 1863 while he was in the war.

William served as the postmaster at Dunavant for a number of years.

Mary Esther Byram McClenny ..... She was the daughter of Elias and Harriet Byram, and came with her parents to Kansas in the fall of 1865 and settled on a farm in the Spring Grove district and our acquaintance began there. The family were above the average pioneer family in refinement and education. They immediately took hold to help in the social and church life of the neighborhood. Mary Esther as her mother called her having a splendid alto voice and was willing to help with her voice at church or funeral services and soon became a friend to us all.

Two sons in the Byram family had served in the Civil War and Charlie a pale boy was just recovering from the loss of his right arm which had been amputated at the shoulder after the battle of Nashville.

How our hearts went in pity to him the entire family won the hearts of all the neighbors.

In the fall of the year 1865, Hetty as we called her taught a short term of school in the district and the writer was her only pupil for several days, and what friends we became.

We both married and sometimes in our busy lives we did not see each other for sometime but the love and friendship remained and has gone down to our children's children.

She was married to W.C. McClenny, Sept 12, 1866, who was called to his heavenly home, Sept. 16, 1916; also three of her sons, John, William C. Jr., and Otis preceded her.

There are seven children remaining to mourn the loss of a mother who was never too busy to loose her interest and prayers in anything that was for their best welfare.

The little church at Dunavant was near to her heart, and her devotion and faithfulness to it was beautiful. Many friends mourn with the family in the loss of this sweet Christian character. She is survived by seven children, Mrs. Ida Wilson, Messrs Elias; Fred; J.B. and George McClenny; Mrs. Nellie Becker and Mrs. Fred Coulsen, 26 grandchildren and 19 great grandchildren. "She led them through the labyrinth of youth. And broght fine men and women up to truth."

"Chas. Orville ROGERS of 1170 Lincoln street, Denver, was instantly killed at about 3 o'clock yesterday afternoon when the car he was driving turned over and crashed on the state highway two miles west of Gypsum. ROGERS and a companion Dean MCCLENNY, also of Denver were enroute to Aspen when the accident occurred. According to MCCLENNY, ROGERS was driving at a speed of about 45 miles an hour, when he pulled the car from the center of the road to the right side and run into some loose gravel which caused the car to skid, turn over and smash up. ROGERS was pinned under the steering wheel, and was dead when taken out of the wreck a few minutes later.

County Surveyor A. H. ADAMS and Mrs. ADAMS came along in their car a few minutes later the accident occurred and with the help of others got the body out and took it to Gypsum, where Dr. W. L. CONWAY gave the opinion that death had been almost instant.

ROGERS was about 45 years of age, and had both legs off, wearing two artificial limbs. He was a widower, and has one son living in Nebraska. He was a traveling salesman, selling artificial limbs.

And the annual camping trip took the family to the 48 contiguous states and many world fairs and natural wonders. The love of his life was his wife, Mary Grace, and his five children, 17 grandchildren and two great-grandchildren. He and Mary Grace Burkhardt were married July 21, 1946, in Topeka. He is survived by this wife and children: Steve Morgan and his wife, Paula of Overland Park; Susan Thompson and her husband, Lee of Wichita; Sally Huggins and her husband, Howard of Overland Park; Cindy Lafferty and her husband, George of Fairway and Scott Morgan and his wife, Kathleen of Lawrence, KS.

Ray also was passionate about politics and writing and was a veteran of more than 50 years as a working journalist, primarily covering politics. He began his career as a newsman with the Topeka Daily Capital in Topeka, KS, covering his first national political convention in 1948 when the Republicans nominated Thomas E. Dewey in Philadelphia and covering his first session of the Kansas Legislature in 1947. He reported on politics, legislative matters and general news for The Daily Capital from 1945 to 1951. In 1951, Ray joined the staff of the Kansas City Times and Star covering political, legislative and special events. He was named Kansas Correspondent for the Times in 1953, and continued in that capacity until 1977. As chief Kansas political correspondent for the Times and the Star, and as a writer and columnist, he knew and covered every Kansas Governor in the second half of the 20th century, personally reported the nomination of Bob Dole as Vice President of the United States in 1976, and covered every U.S. Senate, gubernatorial and congressional race in Kansas during those years. Ray also covered news events in Europe, Latin America, Asia and Africa. In 1956, he was named by Sen.
